Can – can't/cannot (können, dürfen – nicht können)

Ben can walk to school; it's only five minutes.

Nick <u>can ride</u> to school on his bike in three minutes. Sanjay <u>can't go</u> to school by bike.

Nick and Debbie <u>can watch</u> TV until eight pm.

They **<u>can watch</u>** films for children.

Must –mustn't/ must not (müssen – nicht <u>dürfen</u>)

Miss Hunt **must drive** to school.

Susan <u>must go</u> to school by bus.

Josef **<u>must take</u>** the train from Mittenwald.

They **mustn't watch** TV until midnight.

They **mustn't watch** dirty films.

May I...? : Darf ich...?

May I have another sandwich?

May I invite my friend this afternoon?

May I watch TV in the afternoon?

Nicht müssen/nicht brauchen:needn't

Ben <u>needn't walk</u> to school. He can take the bike or the bus. Pupils <u>needn't do</u> their homework in the afternoon; they can do it in the evening. Josef <u>needn't help</u> them on Sundays .
