 - d) **Who** do Debbie and Nick help in the house on Saturday mornings?
 - e) **Where** do Debbie and Nick help their parents on Saturday mornings?
- 2) Debbie_(b) makes_(a) the bed_(c).
 - a) **Who** makes the beds?
 - b) **What** does Debbie do?
 - c) **What** does Debbie make?
- 3) Nick_(a) washes_(b) the dishes_(c).
 - a) **Who** washes the dishes?
 - b) **What** does Nick do?
 - c) **What** does Nick wash?
- 4) Ben_(a) plays_(b) in the school team_(c), too.
 - a) **Who** plays in the school team, too?
 - b) **What** does Ben do [in the school team], too?
 - c) **Where** does Ben play [,too] ?
- 5) Ben_(a) plays_(b) for the Kingsway_(c) team.
 - a) **Who** plays for the Kingsway team?
 - b) **What** does Ben do?
 - c) **Who** does Ben play for? [**For which** team does Ben play? Or: **Which** team does Ben play **for**?]
- 6) Jenny_(a) always sleeps late_(b) on Saturday mornings_(c).
 - a) **Who** sleeps always late on Saturday mornings?
 - b) **What** does Jenny always do on Saturday mornings?
 - c) **When** does Jenny always sleep late?
- 7) This Saturday_(a) Nick and Ben_(b) play_(c) against their big rivals_(d).
 - a) **When** do Nick and Ben play against their big rivals?
 - b) **Who** plays against the big rivals this Saturday?
 - c) **What** do Nick and Ben do this Saturday?
 - d) **Who** do Nick and Ben play against this Saturday?
- 8) At half-time_(a) the teams_(b) always eat_(c) oranges_(d).
 - a) **When** do the teams always eat oranges?
 - b) **Who** eats oranges at half-time?
 - c) **What** do the teams always do at half-time?
 - d) **What** do the teams always eat at half-time?
- 9) Mr Martin_(a) sits down_(b) on the bench_(c) at half-time_(d).
 - a) **Who** sits down on the bench at half-time?
 - b) **What** does Martin do at half-time?
 - c) **Where** does Martin sit [down] at half-time?
 - d) **When** does Martin sit down on the bench?
- 10) He takes off_(a) one shoe_(b) at half-time_(c), because_(d) it is too small.
 - a) **What** does he [Mr Martin] do at half-time?
 - b) **What** does he take off at half-time?
