Sometimes a neighbor brings (21-bringen) a nice young cat to the surgery, because this cat needs (22-brauchen) help. That's how Sid always

finds (23-finden-immer) nice girl friends. In the afternoon he always goes (24-gehen-immer) to this cat's house and miaows under/in front of (25-) her window. When she comes out, he takes her 26) to a garden and shows (27-zeigen) her how she can find a mouse. That's why many cats love (28-lieben) Sid. When Dave comes home from (29-) school and does (30-) his homework, Sid often watches (31-zuschauen-oft) him. In the evening Sid usually sits (32-sitzen-gewöhnlich) in the Prestons' (33-Prestons) living room and watches (34) TV with them. Sid loves (35-lieben) TV films with cats, mice or budgies. He goes (36-) to bed with Dave and sleeps (37) under Dave's bed. The Prestons (38-Prestons) are a wonderful family for (39) pets. So Sid has got/lives (40) a wonderful life in the Prestons' (41-Prestons) house.
