### **Mudchute Farm and Park**

Mudchute Farm is a very big city farm in Greenwich on the Isle of Dogs with lots of animals for you. The large farm animals like cows, sheep, and goats are in the fields, where they can eat their favourite food: grass. If you are lucky, you can watch how a mother sheep lets her lamb drink milk from her. The horses and ponies are in the Riding Centre; you can ride on them if you book a riding lesson. The small animals are in the Pets Corner. Parents can book a small animal for their children; so a child can play alone with a rabbit or a guinea pig and hold it in his or her hands. This is a very popular activity. You can book a farm tour with one of our tour guides: Bob Green takes you around the farm and tells you a lot of interesting things about the animals. But be careful: come early, because lots of animals go to bed at four o'clock.

The farm doesn't open on Mondays. It's open on all other days of the week from nine o'clock to five o'clock. And the best thing is: it doesn't cost a lot of money, but is free. You can take your own picnic or have a snack at Mudchute Kitchen.
