Fill in **some** or **any**, **prepositions** and **short answers**, **verb forms**:

Luke: I'm ⁽¹⁾ a techno fan. England is great **for/at/in**⁽²⁾ techno music. I've got **some** ⁽³⁾ great CDs **at** ⁽⁴⁾ home.

Dave: Techno! Isn't it too loud for **any** ⁽⁵⁾ normal people?

Olivia: Yes, **it is** ⁽⁶⁾. I like disco music.

Pia: Are there **any** ⁽⁷⁾ CD shops **in**⁽⁸⁾ Greenwich?

Olivia: Well, there are **some** ⁽⁹⁾ small shops **in** ⁽¹⁰⁾ town.

Luke: There aren't **any** ⁽¹¹⁾ really big shops.

Olivia: Let's go **to** ⁽¹²⁾ that small shop **over** ⁽¹³⁾ there. It **isn't** ⁽¹⁴⁾ bad. We can **listen** ⁽¹⁵⁾ to **some** ⁽¹⁶⁾ good music there.

Pia: OK, maybe I can buy **some** ⁽¹⁷⁾ CDs there.

Dave: Have you got **any** ⁽¹⁸⁾ money, Pia?

Pia: Yes, **I have** ⁽¹⁹⁾. Well, I **haven't** ⁽²⁰⁾ got **any** ⁽²¹⁾ English money. But I've got **some** ⁽²²⁾ euros. Can't I pay **with** ⁽²³⁾ euros here?

Dave: No, **you can't** ⁽²⁴⁾.

Olivia: Well, Pia, I can give you **some** ⁽²⁵⁾ English pounds. And you give me **some** ⁽²⁶⁾ euros when I go **to** ⁽²⁷⁾ Berlin **with** ⁽²⁸⁾ you.

Pia: Maybe I can buy **some** ⁽²⁹⁾ CDs ____⁽³⁰⁾ German music. So your parents can listen **to** ⁽³¹⁾ **some** ⁽³²⁾ German music.

Let's go **in** ⁽³³⁾.

Now they are in the shop and are talking to the shop assistant::

Shop a.: Can I **help** ⁽³⁴⁾ you?

Pia: Yes, **you can** ⁽³⁵⁾. Have you got **any** ⁽³⁶⁾ CDs **with** ⁽³⁷⁾ German pop music?

Shop a.: I'm sorry. We haven't got **any** ⁽³⁸⁾ modern German music. But we've got **some** ⁽³⁹⁾ CDs **with** ⁽⁴⁰⁾ Mozart's music.

Pia: Oh no, I **don't** ⁽⁴¹⁾ want **any** ⁽⁴²⁾ CDs **of/with** ⁽⁴³⁾ Mozart or Beethoven. I'm looking **for** ⁽⁴⁴⁾ **some** ⁽⁴⁵⁾ modern German pop music.

Olivia: And I'd like **some** ⁽⁴⁶⁾ disco music. Have you got **any** ⁽⁴⁷⁾?

Shop a.: Yes, **we have** ⁽⁴⁸⁾. I can show you **some** ⁽⁴⁹⁾ CDs over there.

Olivia: That's wonderful. Can we listen **to** ⁽⁵⁰⁾ **some/any** ⁽⁵¹⁾ CDs?

After half an hour they buy **some** ⁽⁵²⁾ CDs and **go** ⁽⁵³⁾ home again.
