

Can – can't/cannot

(können, dürfen – nicht können, nicht dürfen)

Pia **can walk** to school; it's only five minutes.

Olivia **can ride** to school on her bike.

Jay **can't go** to school by bike today.

Holly and Amber **can watch** TV until eight pm.

They **can't watch** TV until midnight.

They **can watch** films for children.

Must – mustn't/ must not

(müssen – **nicht dürfen**)

Luke's dad **must drive** to work.

Mike **must go** to school by bus.

Seppi **must take** the train from Mittenwald.

They **mustn't watch** TV until midnight.

They **mustn't watch** dirty films.

Müssen: must

Luke **must go** to school every day.

Students **must do** their homework.

Josef **must help** his parents .

Nicht müssen/nicht brauchen:**needn't**

Dave **needn't walk** to school. He can take the bike or the bus.

Pupils **needn't do** their homework in the afternoon; they can do it in the evening.

Josef **needn't help** them on Sundays .
