Holly and Amber <u>can watch</u> TV until eight pm. They <u>can't watch</u> TV until midnight. They <u>can watch</u> films for children. Must -mustn't/ must not (müssen - nicht dürfen)

Luke's dad **must drive** to work.

Mike **must go** to school by bus.

Seppi **must take** the train from Mittenwald.

They mustn't watch TV until midnight.

They mustn't watch dirty films.

Müssen: must

Luke **must go** to school every day.

Students **must do** their homework.

Josef **must help** his parents.

Nicht müssen/nicht brauchen:needn't

Dave <u>needn't walk</u> to school. He can take the bike or the bus.

Pupils <u>needn't do</u> their homework in the afternoon; they can do it in the evening.

Josef <u>needn't help</u> them on Sundays.
