

## Exercise 1:

**Connect the clauses with “and, where, when/if, that, because”:**

Olivia is looking for information on Mudchute Farm and Park **because** (1) she wants to visit it with her family and her friends. She googles it **and** (2) finds the website of Mudchute Farm & Park. She is happy **because** (3) she finds lots of information on their website. It says **that** (4) the farm is open from Tuesday to Sunday, **but** (5) it doesn't open on Mondays. The pictures on the website show Olivia **that** (6) the farm is nice **and** (7) has got lots of animals.

The large farm animals are in the fields, **but** (8) the small animals are in the Pets Corner. The farm animals usually are under a roof **when** (9) it rains. The horses and ponies are in the Riding Centre, **but** (10) you can ride on them in the fields. **When/If** (11) you want to ride on a horse, your parents must book a horse for you. The best thing is **that** (12) it doesn't cost any money. It's free, **when/if** (14) their child wants to play with a hamster or a rabbit or a guinea pig alone. This is important **because** (15) Lucy loves rabbits **and** (16) wants to play with a rabbit alone. Lucy thinks **that** (17) rabbits love her, too.

The website says **that** (18) you can have lunch at Mudchute Kitchen, **but** (19) you can also bring your own picnic **and** (20) eat it at the picnic area **if** (21) a tasty snack at Mudchute Kitchen is too expensive for you.

The Frasers like the idea of a visit to Mudchute Farm **and** (22) tell Holly about it. They don't want to go on a Sunday **because** (23) lots of people go there on Sundays. The Frasers want to go on Saturday, **but** (24) Holly and her sister usually visit their dad every Saturday. Holly's dad tells her **that** (25) they can visit him on Sunday. It means **that** (26) Holly can come along with the Frasers. Olivia wants to invite Amber, too, **but** (27) Amber never likes to say yes. Holly likes the idea of a picnic **because** (28) her mother can never give her much pocket money.

Now they all keep their fingers crossed **because** (29) they hope for good weather on Saturday.
