Mike: “I don’t know. They **not** a lake,
(sie **haben** **vielleicht** **keinen** See)
but they a swimming-pool.”
(aber sie **haben** **vielleicht**..)

Luke: “Why don’t you take a holiday job and earn some money?”

Mike: “.That’s a good idea. I in my uncle’s restaurant.”
(ich **arbeite** **vielleicht**...)

Luke: “Has he got a job for you there?”

Mike: “I don’t know. He my help if there’s a lockdown again.”
(er **braucht** **vielleicht** **keine** Hilfe)

Luke: “ Why don’t we just go to my grandparents’ farm together?”

Mike: “Great idea. But they both of us.”
(sie **wollen** **vielleicht** **nicht** beide von uns.)

Luke: “Don’t worry. Their house is always open for all my friends.
