- 1) *Before*₍₁₎ we can drive to our grandparents in Tyrol, my dad has to pack the car. *By the time*₍₂₎ he has put all the suitcases and boxes into the car, he is already very tired. *After*₍₃₎ we all have got into the car and shut the doors, my dad checks if everyone has put the seatbelts on. *When*₍₄₎ we finally start, everybody takes out a book or an iPad for the trip, because *during*₍₅₎ the trip we read or watch some videos. *While*₍₆₎ my dad is driving, we are reading or watching a video. *By the time*₍₇₎ we arrive at our grandparents' , we are really hungry. *Before*₍₈₎ we get lunch, we have to unpack the car. *After*₍₉₎ carrying the suitcases to

our rooms, we settle down to lunch. *During*⁽¹⁰⁾ lunch we don't talk much, because we are hungry and concentrate on eating.

After⁽¹¹⁾ lunch my parents take a break *until*⁽¹²⁾ three o'clock.

During⁽¹³⁾ that time everybody can do what he likes. *While*⁽¹⁴⁾

my parents are resting, my sister is watching a video and I am reading a book. *After*⁽¹⁵⁾ this break we go outside into the

garden or to the forest. *While*⁽¹⁶⁾ my sister is looking for wood

in the forest, I'm splitting wood with an ax. It's my favourite

activity *when*⁽¹⁷⁾ I stay with my grandparents. *By the time*⁽¹⁸⁾

we go back to the house again, we are really hungry and thirsty.
