Write down what Sherlocky <u>usually/often etc. does.</u>

Put the frequency adverbs into the correct position:

- (Monday, always, Sherlock, get up, early)
 On Mondays Sherlock <u>always</u> gets up early.
- 2) (usually, he, sit, in his office, after breakfast)He <u>usually</u> sits in his office after breakfast.
- 3) (often, the phone, ring, in the morning)The phone often rings in the morning
- 4) (always, people, have got, problems, with animals)

 People have <u>always</u> got problems with animal.
- 5) (they often, need, help, from Sherlock)
 They often need help from Sherlock.
- 6) (always, Lady Grey, worry, about Pepper, cat);Lady Grey <u>always</u> worries about her cat Pepper. [or: Pepper, her cat]
- 7) (often, Pepper, run away, into the woods.)
 Pepper often runs away into the woods.
- 8) (sometimes, Pepper, look for, adventure, there)
 Pepper <u>sometimes</u> looks for adventure there
 [or: Sometimes pepper looks for adventure there.]]
- 9) (usually, Pepper, meet, boyfriend, there)
 Pepper <u>usually</u> meets her boyfriend there.
- 10)(Then, always, Lady Grey, call, Sherlock,)
 Then Lady Grey <u>always</u> calls Sherlock.
- 11) (usually, she, ask, him, help)

 She <u>usually</u> asks him for help.
- 12) (then, always, Sherlock, look for, Pepper, woods)

Then Sherlock <u>always</u> looks for Pepper in the woods.

- 13) (often, he, find, her, tree, woods,)He often finds her in a tree in the woods.
- 14) (always, Lady Grey, call, him, the world's best detective,)

 Lady Grey always calls him the world's best detective.
- 15) (always, Lady Grey's words, make, him, very happy Lady Grey's words always make him very happy.
